BIJUTSU TARO 美術 太郎 Akita, Japan, 1975

BIJUTSU Taro | BT (b. 1975) was born in Akita Prefecture, graduated from Tama Art University. He started his career by selling self-made postcards on the streets. He criticizes that artwork should not be evaluated based on the brand name or artist's fame. Therefore he continues to produce work under the name "BIJUTSU Taro | BT" without disclosing his identity (He has never revealed his real name and any photographs of himself in public). He wants people to appreciate the art for what it is, but not for it to be bound by the artist's name or look. Hence, anyone can create art under the name "BIJUTSU Taro | BT", and that the art will continue to grow beyond the limits of time or constraints of material.

"I believe that Art nourishes the Heart and Sou The Power of Art We can get over the difficulties together"

Instead of Art becoming luxury item for the rich, BT is hoping his work to be the nourishments for the poor who needs art. BT says, "I rather draw 100 paintings for 10,000 Yen than do 1 painting for 1 Million Yen, I hope that my art gently provides nourishment to everyone's heart."

BI says, "I am not an Artist with a strong painting style. I am still trying to look beyond what is beyond the blank spaces of the painting. Although art cannot exist without being linked to the society, if there are no tolerance in the art then there is no point for its existence. It is not because we do not see beneath the inconvenient truth, but perhaps it's because we are not trying to look for it at all". Nowadays there are many cases where art is highlighted and speculated from a close-up point of view. Going back to the roots of painting, to quietly converse with the art, this is an important and valuable experience to face our subconsciousness. We live in a time where uncertainty gives us indecent levels of anxiety, inside the world of BT where the strong transmission is sent to the depths of the people's heart and will fascinate them.




